Our Clinical Model

Josh Spurlock and the MCO team have developed a proprietary model of care named: **Neuroscience Informed Christian Counseling** • The model begins with the premise that the author of the Bible and the author of our nervous system are one and the same, Jesus. The accurate study of both will find no conflict with each other. We call this kind of study *neurotheology*. Our model relies on attunement to the nervous system and Holy Spirit to guide therapeutic work. Interventions are experiential and emotion focused.
